B. Reading Improvement – Acadience and RI Data

a. School-wide – Generally our school doesn't perform as well as the district. For the last 2 years, our Acadience data has shown that we are close to district percentages for proficiencies. Council goal is 65% at typical or above growth (statistically 60% is typical for growth), currently as a school we are at 58.1% growth. RI (3rd-6th) growth is up 13% at 55% proficient or above.
